



ISE Go Apps!

Anytime, Anyplace, Any Device

Welcome to a new virtual application technology that allows you to connect to all of the Industrial & System Engineering applications and use them on your own system or device as if they were installed locally. You will even have access to your network and local PC files and shares so that you can save files in your H: drive or your local hard drive. To use this system, you will need to install a Citrix Receiver and have a valid computer account (you may obtain an account from rm. 3005B). You will also need to have Internet access. VPN is not required.

For Windows, Macs, and Linux:

To access the virtual applications, go to <https://ISEGoApps.TAMU.EDU>, click "OK" on the Texas A&M security statement, and then click the green "Install" button. A new window will open at the Citrix download page where you will select "Citrix Receiver" in the drop down bar. Next, choose the appropriate receiver for your operating system and install. Return to the original Go Apps site and login to access the apps.

Tips:

Performance will be best when you use files located on one of the network drives (H:) versus your local computer.



For iPads, iPhones, Droid tablets, phones, and other devices:

Simply install the Citrix Receiver app from the appropriate app store or market per your device. Once installed, use <https://ISEGoApps.tamu.edu> for the application site.
